❖ The player may apply for no more than two ages, is in his or her own player age, and is older in one age, but may submit no more than three events in total.

Example:

- BS-U15, BS-U17, BD-U15
- GS-U19, WS, GD-U19
- BS-U15, BS-U17, BS-U19
- GS-U17, GS-U19, WS

❖ All entries must be made using the Entry Form.

❖ Entries close on **27th May 2026** for Thai player and close on **20th May 2026** for sending passport copy of international player. (**U-9, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 and Open**)

❖ Late entries may be rejected at the discretion of the organizer.

❖ Entries submitted by National Associations must be in **ranked order** for all events.

❖ National Associations will be notified whether their players have been accepted into the tournament or are placed in the reserved list as soon as possible, after the closing date. The information will be published and updated on the website:

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and shall comply with the BWF General Competition Regulations (GCR).
2. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he / she is
 - a) Under the jurisdiction of a Member Association of the Federation
 - b) Has been declared in good standing with that Member Association
3. The Organizers reserve the right to decide on the numbers of entries admitted into the qualifying rounds.
4. **For U-9, U-11, U-13, U-15, U-17, U-19 and Open**, Seedings and draws will be conducted by BAT. **The draws will be conducted 2nd June 2026**
5. Alteration of the competition schedule due to unforeseen circumstances may arise and will be announced by the Referee accordingly.
6. **Scoring System:**
The rally point scoring system shall be used (3X21)
7. **Withdrawal:**
Notification of withdrawal(s) with reason must be given immediately to the Tournament Secretary by email to **entryonline.bat@gmail.com** please CC: **btytournament.thai@gmail.com** Withdrawal(s) made after **29th May 2026** due to injury or illness must be supported by a medical certificate. The Organizing Committee will require documentary evidence to support withdrawal(s) for any other reason. If withdrawal arises after players have arrived in Thailand, notification of withdrawal, accompanied by supporting document, must be made in person to the Referee or his deputy.

CLOTHING / ADVERTISING

All players shall wear badminton playing attire in compliance with the regulations of the Badminton Association of Thailand under Royal Patronage (BAT).

These regulations are issued with reference to the Regulations of the Badminton Association of Thailand under Royal Patronage on the Organization of Domestic Badminton Tournaments B.E. 2568 (2025).

- In all matches of this tournament, which is sanctioned by the Association, playing clothing shall comply with the BWF GCR. Each item of playing clothing shall be of a single colour or a combination of colours.

- Singles Events

In Singles Events, from the Quarterfinals onwards, the colours, colour tones, and patterns of the shirt and shorts (or equivalent playing attire) worn by a player shall be similar and consistent throughout the match.

- Doubles Events

In Doubles Events, from the Quarterfinals onwards, players of the same side shall wear shirts and shorts (or equivalent playing attire) of the same or similar colours, colour tones, and patterns.

The same colours or colour tones shall be worn throughout the entire match. Changing playing attire to a different colour during a match shall not be permitted.

- from the Quarterfinals onwards, where opposing players or pairs are not wearing clearly distinguishable colours, the player or pair with the lower world or seeding ranking (as applicable) shall be required to change their playing attire

- Design and Advertising Content

The design of all playing clothing shall be abstract in nature. No commercial advertising, business-related content, hidden promotional messages, metaphorical wording, or clearly identifiable images shall be permitted

- Lettering and Advertising on Players' Clothing

- Lettering displayed on the back of the shirt (player's name, club) shall be in Thai or Roman alphabet, in uppercase letters (if applicable), and in a single colour clearly contrasting with the colour of the shirt.

- The height of the player's name shall be not less than 6 centimetres and not more than 10 centimetres (if any).

- The height of the country name or association/club shall be 5 centimetres (if any). (club name used for registration must be the same club under which the entry is submitted.)

- All lettering shall be positioned horizontally and placed near the upper part of the back of the shirt.

- The order of information displayed on the back of the shirt, from top to bottom, shall be:

player's name (if any), country name or association/club (if any), and advertising band (if any).

- Advertising may be displayed only in the positions permitted under the BWF GCR, namely: left sleeve, right sleeve, left collar, right collar, left front shoulder, right front shoulder, left chest, right chest, and centre chest.

Each individual advertisement shall not exceed 35 square centimetres, and the total number of advertising placements shall not exceed eight (8), with a maximum of one (1) advertisement per position.

A national flag, if displayed, shall be considered advertising.

- Advertising Bands Front of the Shirt

Advertising bands may be placed in any orientation, provided that the width or height does not exceed 10 centimetres

- Advertising Bands Back of the Shirt

Advertising bands shall not exceed 5 centimetres in height.

- Each sock or compression sleeve may display a maximum of two (2) advertisements per item, with each advertisement not exceeding 20 square centimetres,

- Other items of playing attire may display 1 advertisement per item, with each advertisement not exceeding 20 square centimetres, such as wristbands or headbands.

Exception: shorts or skirts may display up to 2 advertisements

- Any additional playing attire worn underneath the shirt, shorts, or skirt that is visible shall not contain any advertising.
